2012 Red Cross Kart Racing Series TEAM SAFETY RULES AND AGREEMENT FORM

In order for your team drivers to qualify for this year's Red Cross Kart Racing Series, we first ask that certain tasks be completed and everyone involved agree to abide by all rules and regulations:

1. Please remember the purpose behind the Red Cross Kart Racing, to raise money for the American Red Cross.
 - a. Disaster Services-providing the essential emergency food, clothing & shelter to those affected by a disaster.
 - b. Service to the Armed Forces- the military authorities, military families & service men & women rely on the Red Cross to provide the link for emergency communications between our service members and their loved ones at home.
 - c. Health & Safety Services- teaching people life-saving skills. From CPR to First Aid to Lifeguarding to Babysitting.
 - d. Blood Services- supplying over half of the nation's blood supply to hospitals. Each unit collected could save up to 3 lives!
2. The Red Cross is a not for profit organization that receives no funding from the government. We rely heavily on the generosity of the American people and fundraisers like the Kart Races to ensure the Red Cross is able to assist our friends and neighbors when they need it the most.
3. We are a volunteer-led organization with over 90% of our staff being volunteers. We rely on their dedication and generosity to help fulfill the Red Cross mission. THANK YOU for your help and time!!!
4. Read and understood all rules and regulations as listed.
5. Each team member must attend the team meetings.
6. All rules applied to the modification or use of the kart must be strictly adhered to.
7. All team members will conduct themselves in a sportsman-like manner at all times.
8. Any decision made by the racing event officials (ie. Flagmen, Trustees) will be final.
9. All team members are responsible for their behavior as well as the individuals in their pits.
10. All team members are to conduct themselves in mature, respectful manner as representatives of the American Red Cross.

In order to create a safe and competitive environment both on and off the track, your compliance is required. The American Red Cross and the Red Cross Kart Racing Committee & Trustees thank you for your support and participation!!!

In addition to agreeing to abide by the above rules and regulations, I assume full responsibility of the kart and understand that I forfeit my entry fee and participation in the kart series if the kart is damaged or destroyed or if for any reason the team is unable to race the series &/or an event.

CONSENT FORM

I am at least 16 years of age an am fully insured, **possess and have available for verification the day of the event** a valid driver's license and have signed a waiver of liability and indemnity agreement and team safety rules and agreement form.

I SHALL INDEMNIFY, defend (with counsel approved by American Red Cross) and hold harmless the Ft Recovery Jubilee, the St Henry 175th Celebration, the Maria Stein Country Fest, Inc., the Eldora Speedway, the Mercer County Fair, the Ft. Recovery Ambassadors, JR Manufacturing, Ken-bar Products, the American Red Cross, and the entities directors, officers, volunteers, employees and agents harmless from claims (including reasonable attorney's fees and court cost related to such claims) which: (I.) arise from personal injury, death, or third-party property damage; (II.) arise from incidents occurring in or about the Ft Recovery Jubilee, the Maria Stein Country Fest, Inc., Eldora Speedway, the St. Henry 175th Celebration, the Mercer County Fair and the Ft. Recovery Ambassadors; and (III.) caused by the negligent or willful misconduct of the participant, its directors, officers, employees, agents, clients or invitees. This indemnity obligation shall survive this agreement.
2. I HERBY RELEASE, WAIVE, DISCHARGE AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE all said entities, its officers and members; officials, employees, volunteers, agents or any other person or entity working in conjunction with the American Red Cross Kart Racing Series, all for the purpose herein referred to as Releasees, from all liability to the undersigned, its personal representatives, assign, heirs and next of kin for all loss or damage, and claim or demands therefore, on account of injury to the person or the property herein caused by the negligence of Releasees or otherwise while the undersigned is participating in the American Red Cross Kart Racing Series, in any manner;
3. I HEREBY AGREE TO INDEMNIFY AND SAVE AND HOLD HARMLESS the Releasees and each of them from any loss, liability, damage of cost they may incur due to the participation of the undersigned, its Agents or other workers working in conjunction with it in or upon the designated area of the American Red Cross Kart Racing Series, and whether caused by the negligence of the releases of otherwise; and
4. I HEREBY ASSUME FULL RESPONSIBILITY FOR AND RISK OF BODILY INJURY, DEATH, OR PROPERTY DAMAGE due to the negligence of releases of otherwise while participating in the American Red Cross Kart Series, and while setting up, working, observing, or otherwise participating in such event.

I expressly acknowledge and agree that the activities of the event are very dangerous and involve the risk of serious injury and/or death and/or property damage. I further expressly agree that the foregoing release, waiver, and indemnity agreement is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by the law of the State of Ohio, and that the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect.
